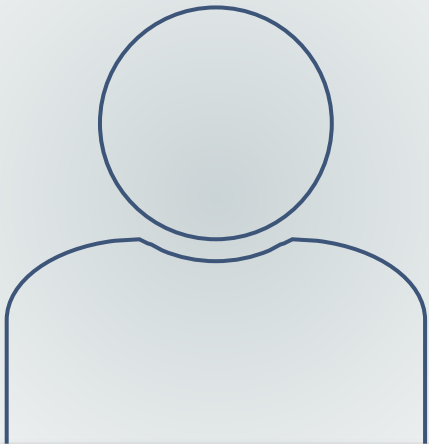

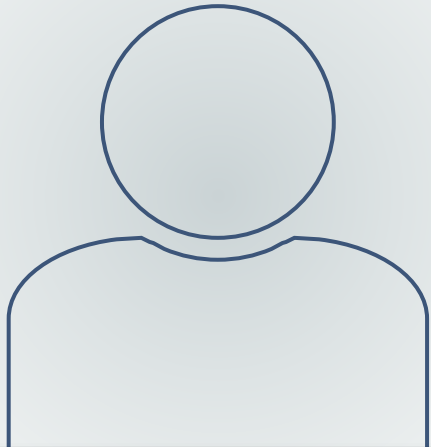
Yifan currently heads up the analytics team for Aon Benfield Greater China and leads the APAC actuarial best practice.
